
Apsley Cherry Garrard 1886 - 1959



Fact File

Born in 1886 at Lamer House

Cherry was nicknamed 'Cheery' because he was cheerful and willing.

Travelled with Scott to the Antarctic. after donating £1,000 to the expedition

Walked for 100 miles in complete darkness for five weeks at temperatures of -76 degrees Fahrenheit in search of Emperor penguin eggs.

He shivered so much that all of his teeth shattered in the cold

Went back to recover Scott's body the following spring.

Cherry wrote a book about the expedition . George Bernard Shaw, the great writer, helped him.
