He regularly cycled to Wheathampstead Station from Ayot St. Lawrence. The station master would make the train wait for Mr. Shaw

At Christmas, Shaw gave every child in Wheathampstead a shilling. They were told not to give it to their parents!

He died aged 94 after falling out of a tree.
