

## **Welwyn Archaeological Society Outing - Saturday 2nd June**

On Saturday 2nd June, the Welwyn Archaeological Society is going on a coach outing to West Stow Anglo-Saxon Village, Bury St. Edmunds and Grime's Graves Neolithic Flint Mine. The coach leaves Wheathampstead Memorial Hall at 8:45, making pick-up stops in Welwyn (Civic Centre) and Welwyn Garden City (by the old Police Station) before heading to West Stow. In addition to the reconstructed Anglo-Saxon village, West Stow is hosting the 95th Rifles, a Peninsular War re-enactment group, on that day. After our visit to West Stow, the coach will make a stop in Bury St Edmunds, where we can have lunch. In the afternoon you have a choice. Either remain in Bury St Edmunds exploring the town, or board the coach for a visit to Grime's Graves Neolithic Flint mines. The coach will return to Bury St Edmunds to pick everyone up at 4:00, then head back to Hertfordshire.

Tickets cost £36 per person, which includes the coach fare and entry to West Stow. Grime's Graves is an English Heritage site and there will be an extra charge of approximately £4 (depending on how many people we get for that part of the trip).
